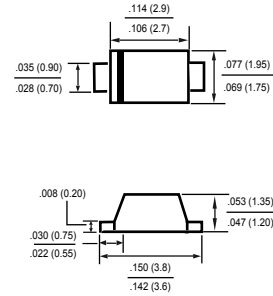

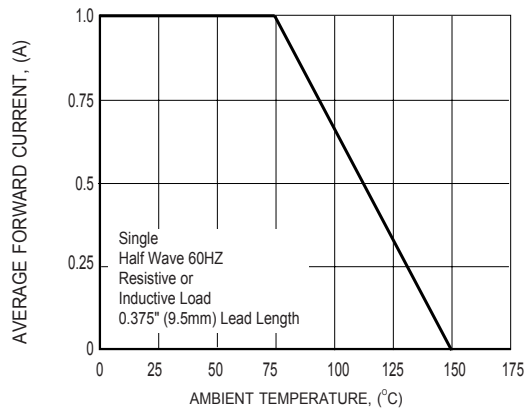


FIG.1 TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

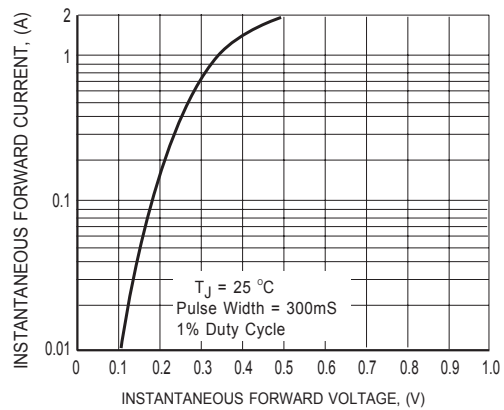


FIG.2 TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

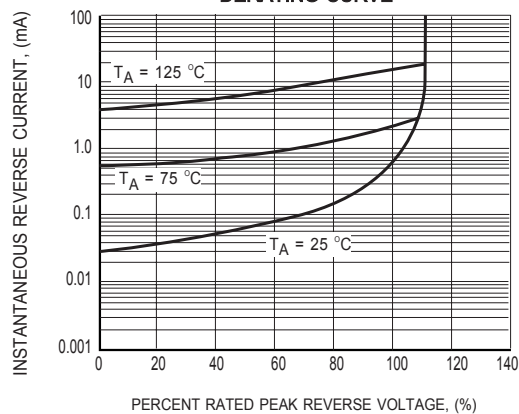


FIG.3 TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

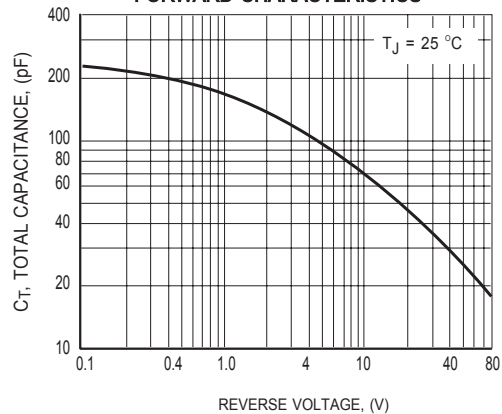


FIG.4 TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

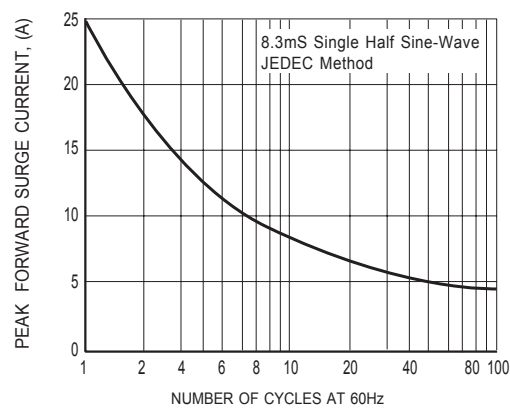
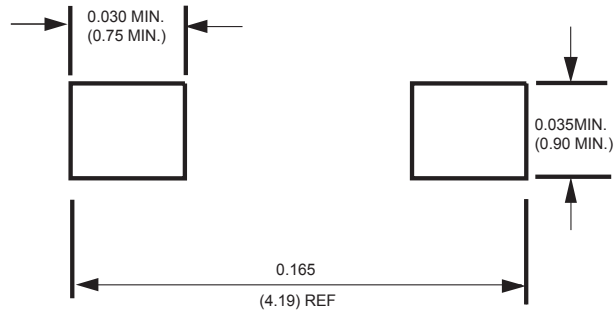


FIG.5 MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT
